Sealed the 29th October 1878, and dated the 8th May 1878.











THE GARRETT SUBMARINE TORPEDO BOAT

# The Loss of Resurgam


**25 February 1880** 

It was at Rhyl that the voyage ended. No one can say what happened to the Resurgam, for she was missing one evening when the crew came back from enjoying a meal ashore.
